FAIRFIELD MAKES FIRST NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCE

After winning the 2012 MAAC Men's Tennis Championship and receiving their first-ever berth in the NCAA Tournament, Fairfield (16-4) heads to Los Angeles, Calif. to play in the first round against first-seeded Southern California.

A LOOK AT #1 USC

The Trojans enter the NCAA Tournament with a 27-1 record and are coming off their 18th Pac-12 Team Championship. The USC men's tennis team has been on top of the national rankings all season long as the three-time defending national champions. This year, the Trojans have two seniors at the forefront of its push for four. **Steve Johnson** carries what is understood to be an unprecedented 60-match singles win streak into the postseason campaign, where he also is the defending NCAA Singles Champion. **Daniel Nguyen** has been the clincher for the Trojans in two of their past three NCAA Team Championships. Sophomores **Ray Sarmiento** and **Emilio Gomez** have been mainstays in the Trojan lineup since coming to Troy last year for the 2011 title run. This year's NCAA appearance is USC's sixth straight trip to the postseason and 34th overall. USC leads the nation with 19 national championships all-time, and holds an 80-29 overall record in the NCAA Tournament.

A LOOK AT TEXAS A&M

Currently ranked No. 34 in the country, the Aggies (13-14) earned an at-large bid to the 2012 NCAA Men's Tennis Championships, marking the 20th overall appearance and the 19th consecutive. Last year, the Aggies were the No. 9 seed and hosted the first and second rounds defeating Alcorn State and LSU before advancing to the Round of 16 at Stanford where they lost to the host Cardinal, 4-2. Texas A&M is led by three seniors, co-captains **Colin Hoover**, **Alexis Klegou** and **John Lewis**. Klegou is ranked No. 34 in singles while Hoover and Lewis are ranked No. 79 in doubles. The top Aggie duo is freshman **Jackson Withrow** and **Junior Ore** who are ranked No. 47 in the latest rankings.

A LOOK AT SOUTH CAROLINA

The Gamecocks (15-11), ranked 41st by the ITA, earned a spot in the field of 64 for the first time since 2009 with an at-large bid. It is their 20th NCAA Tournament appearance. Sophomore doubles team **Chip Cox** and **Nick Jones** are 24th in the nation with a 7-3 record that includes five wins over top-50 opponents. In singles play, senior **Ivan Machado** holds the No. 108 spot in the nation with a 15-16 overall record. Freshman **Andrew Adams** earned a spot on the SEC All-Freshman Team as he is 28-10 overall, including a 20-6 mark in dual matches. South Carolina is 13-18 all-time in NCAA Tournament matches.

HOW THE STAGS QUALIFIED

Fairfield advanced to the NCAA Championship for the first time in program history after making an impressive run through the MAAC Championships and defeating top-seeded Marist College. The Stags entered the tournament as the two-seed and defeated #3 Niagara in the semifinal, 4-3. Fairfield faced Marist College for the fifth consecutive year in the Championship match. Senior **Dan Sauter** clinched the victory for the Stags at No. 1 singles against MAAC Player of the Year, Lorenzo Rossi, giving Fairfield the 4-3 victory. Sauter was named the 2012 MAAC Tennis Championship Most Outstanding Performer.

NCAA HISTORY

Fairfield won its first MAAC title since the 1997-1998 season and will make its first NCAA appearance in the history of the program. This will also be the first time under head coach **Ed Paige** that the men's team will be traveling to the NCAA Tournament.

BEEN THERE BEFORE

Head Coach **Ed Paige** has been to the NCAA Tournament with the women's team in all four of their NCAA Tournament appearances but this will be his first with the men.

HEAD COACH ED PAIGE



Record at Fairfield/Overall Record 87-44 Sixth Season

Ed Paige, the two-time MAAC Coach of the Year, is in his fifth season at the helm of the men's and women's tennis programs at Fairfield.

In 2012, Paige guided the men to their fifth consecutive MAAC Championship final and the program's first Championship title since the 1997-1998 season. This season marks the first in Fairfield's history that the men have received a NCAA Tournament berth. He also led the women's team to its third MAAC Championship title in four years, the MAAC Regular Season Championship, and an undefeated conference record.

In 2011, under Paige's tutelage, the women's team went undefeated in the regular season clinching the Regular Season Conference title but dropped to Marist, 3-4, in the MAAC Championship final. Similarly, the men had a 5-1 conference record and fell to the Red Foxes in the Championship match. Paige guided numerous All-MAAC honorees, including Women's Player of the Year Monica Yajima and placing ten other student-athletes on their respective All-MAAC First and Second Teams.

In 2010, Paige guided the women's team to its second-straight MAAC Championship title, the MAAC Regular Season Championship, and a program record for victories (19) in a season. He also led the men to their third-straight appearance in the MAAC Championship final.

In Paige's first MAAC Championship season, the men's team set the program record for wins in a season (18), earned a MAAC Regular Season title, and advanced to the MAAC Championship final for the second time in as many seasons. The women's team won six of the last seven matches en route to its first MAAC Championship since 2003-04 and faced seventh-seeded USC in the NCAA Tournament. Paige was named the MAAC Coach of the

Paige, who spent five seasons as an assistant coach for the Stags before accepting the position as head coach, has been involved in tennis as a player, coach and writer for over 30 years.

In addition to his collegiate coaching experience, Paige has coached extensively at the youth level. He spent two years as the Director of Junior Tennis in the town of , Fairfield, and was also an assistant coach for the boy's junior varsity tennis team at Greens Farms Academy in Westport, Conn.

Paige spent six years as an editor at World Tennis Magazine and was the editor of Tennis USA, the United States Tennis Association (USTA) official monthly newspaper. From there Paige worked at some of the top publishing companies in the country, including Paragon House, while teaching feature writing and copy editing at New York University. More recently, Paige spent two years as an editor at *The Advocate*, Stamford's daily newspaper followed by three years as managing editor of *Westport Magazine* before turning his attention to tennis full time

Paige earned a bachelor's degree in English from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in 1974 and attended the Breadloaf School of English at Middlebury College in 1976 and 1977.

ASSISTANT COACH **GLENNY HAY**



Glenny Hay is in her first season as an assistant coach. Born and raised in San Pedro de Macoris, Dominican Republic, Hay came on scholarship to the U.S. to play tennis for Shorter University in Rome, Ga. While there, she earned her bachelor's degree in business administration, graduating in 2006.

During her four years on the team at Shorter, she was an NAIA All-American player and recognized as the best singles and doubles player at Shorter University from 2002-2006. Additional honors for Hay include the NAIA "Best Athlete to Watch" her freshman year, a 2003 Regional title, and a No. 3 ranking in singles as well as a No. 4 ranking in doubles.

Assistant Coach Hay has extensive international playing experience and was inducted into Shorter's Hall of Fame in 2011 for bother her achievements as a student-athlete and her contributions on both the tennis and volleyball teams.

THE NOR'EASTERS

Out of the 64 teams that were chosen for the 2012 NCAA Tournament, only four - Fairleigh Dickinson University, Columbia University, Harvard, and Fairfield - are from the Northeast, All four teams earned their place in the national tournament via automatic bids from their respective con-

COAST TO COAST

Fairfield is the only Northeast team flying to California for the first round. Fairleigh Dickinson and Columbia will both be traveling to Durham, N.C. The Knights will face #3 Virginia while the Lions take on Virginia Commonwealth University in the first round. Harvard will fly down to Florida to open tournament play against Virginia Tech.

2011-12 OPPONENTS IN TOURNAMENT

Fairfield faced players from two NCAA Tournament-bound teams this season, Fairleigh Dickinson and Columbia. The Stags took on individuals from both teams in the fall and faced the Knights once again as a team in Palm Springs, Calif. in the spring dropping to them, 2-5. Individual victories against FDU came from Reece Breault, R.J. Mirabile and Ian Tesmond while wins versus Columbia were clinched by Dennis Zlobinsky and in doubles, Dan Sauter and Zlobinsky. In the spring, Erik Kremheller defeated Dominic Hemy of the Knights 7-6 (8-4), 6-2 at No. 6 singles, while duo Cameron Amyot and Tesmond came out on top of Mark Hemy and Peter Skvarka at No. 3 doubles, 8-6.

ALL-MAAC HONOREES

Fairfield garnered numerous postseason awards from the MAAC. In singles, sophomore lan Tesmond (No. 2) and senior Joe Michalisin (No. 3) earned All-MAAC First team honors. The Stags also swept the All-MAAC First Team doubles honors with **Dan Sauter/Dennis Zlobinsky** at No. 1. Michalisin/Erik Kremheller in the two spot, and Tesmond/Cameron Amyot at No. 3. Fairfield also placed five student-athletes on the MAAC Men's All-Academic team. Michalisin, Kremheller, and sophomores Bjorn Merinder, R.J. Mirabile, and Zlobinsky each earned a spot on the team.

ROLLING ALONG

Senior Dan Sauter has won seven straight matches heading into the NCAA Tournament and is 9-1 in his last 10 matches. Senior Joe Michalisin and junior Erik Kremheller are both 8-2 in their last 10 singles matches and paired together, hold an 11-match winning streak entering the NCAA Tournament. As a duo, Kremheller and Michalisin are 15-5 overall, 13-2 in duals, and a perfect 6-0 in conference play.

STREAKING STAGS

Fairfield is currently riding a seven-match winning streak entering the NCAA Tournament. The Stags' first win in their current streak came back on April 11 at Sacred Heart University with a 7-


