METRO ATLANTIC ATHLETIC CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

Fairfield, which enters the tournament as a winner in eight of its last nine, makes its return to the MAAC Championship for the first time in more than a decade.

The third-seeded Stags (27-26; 14-10 MAAC) will face No. 2 Canisius College (31-25; 16-8 MAAC) in the opening round on Thursday, May 24 at 7pm at Joe Bruno Stadium in Troy, N.Y.

ABOUT THE MAAC CHAMPIONSHIP

The double elimination MAAC Championship will be held May 24-27 at Joe Bruno Stadium in Troy, N.Y. Defending MAAC Champion Manhattan College is the tournament's top seed while Canisius College is the second seed. Fairfield is third while Rider University is the fourth seed.

GETTING BACK TO THE MAAC

This is the Stags first MAAC Championship appearance since 2000 when the Stags went 17-8 and finished third in the MAAC South to qualify for tournament play.

HOW THEY GOT HERE

Entering the final two series of the regular season, the Stags were jockeying for one of the final two spots in the MAAC Championship. Fairfield helped their chances by sweeping three games from Siena College while Manhattan, Canisius, and Rider all secured their spots. Entering the final series of the season against Marist College, the Stags needed just one win against the Red Foxes. Fairfield, behind rookie starter **EJ Ashworth**, pulled out a 1-0 victory in the opener on May 17 to clinch a spot. The Stags then walked off with a 3-2 win in extra innings in the season finale to secure the third seed.

IN THE YEAR 2000...

- Because of rain, the entire 2000 MAAC Championship was played in a day. The Stags played their opening day the campus of host Marist College, defeating LeMoyne College, 3-1. Fairfield headed to Dutchess Stadium for the championship game where they fell to Marist, 11-5.
- The Stags put together the best season in program history, going 26-20. After starting out 2-11, they went on to win 24 of their last 33 games. The Stags also set a new program record for conference wins in a season, finishing third in the league at 17-8.
- Pitcher **Dan Krines**, then in his sophomore year, went 8-2 with a 3.39 ERA. Krines set a new program record as he tossed 103.2 innings this year, completed nine games, and struck out 44 while walking just 14. His eight wins tied another single season program record. He was named to the ABCA/Rawlings Division I Northeast Region Second Team and the All-New England Second Team.
- Relief pitcher **Andrew Gallagher**, the youngest Stag on the current roster, was just six years old (he'd turn seven that following November).
- Starting pitcher **Brett Shulick**, the oldest Stag on the current squad, was 11 years old.
- Current Head Coach **Bill Currier** was at the helm of the University of Vermont while Assistant Coach **Trevor Brown** was in his first season as a pitching coach at Georgetown University. Assistant Coach **Nick Rhodes** was catching in the Tampa Rays farm system.

ROLLING ON 20'S

Fairfield secured its 13th season in program history with at least 20 wins. The Stags have posted a record-setting 27 victories this season, besting the standard of 26 set in 2000.

TURN IT AROUND

After starting league play with a 2-4 record, the Stags turned things around, going 12-6 the rest of the way to finish the regular season with a 14-10 MAAC record. Fairfield was picked seventh in the MAAC Preseason Coaches Poll and ended up finishing third in the league.

FAIRFIELD VS. #2 CANISIUS

Fairfield closed out the month of April by taking two out of three games from Canisius at Alumni Diamond. After enduring a 5-2 loss in the opener, **Scott Warwick** posted a four-hit, complete game shutout with nine strikeouts in the 4-0 victory. In the series finale, the Stags posted a 7-3 victory behind a solid performance by senior pitcher **Brett Shulick**. Freshman **Sebastian Salvo** drove in four runs against the Griffis during that series.

- For his career, **Anthony Hajjar** is batting .357 with five runs and five RBI against Canisius. Shulick owns a 2.77 ERA in two career appearances while **Mark Bordonaro** has a 3.00 ERA with two saves in four career appearances against Canisius.
- Fairfield is 24-21 all-time against Canisius, yet the Griffis have taken 13 of the last 18 meetings.



HEAD COACH BILL CURRIER

Record at Fairfield

The 2011-12 academic year marks Bill Currier's first as head coach of the Fairfield University Stags. During the 2011 season, Currier served as Fairfield's Associate Head Coach, taking over the reins of the program upon the retirement of John Slosar at the end of the season.

Currier spent the 2010 season as a volunteer assistant at the University of Tennessee after spending 22 seasons as the head coach at the University of Vermont. Currier was the winningest coach in Catamount history, posting a 486-470 overall record, including a 240-203 America East record. He helped Vermont win two America East Regular Season Championships and was named America East Coach of the Year three times, in 2002, 2003, and 2006.

Currier was presented with the 2009 Ralph Lapointe Award from the Vermont Sportscasters and Sportswriters Association for his service to athletics. In 2002, he was named the recipient of the New England Intercollegiate Baseball Association's (NEIBA) Jack Butterfield Award, given annually to an active New England coach who exhibits integrity and dedication to the game of baseball. Currier also was inducted into the Vermont Principals Association Hall of Fame in 2005.

Currier, a 1984 graduate of Vermont, was a key member of the Catamounts that advanced to the title game of the 1981 East Coast Athletic Conference New England Regionals. He hit .295 and led the Cats with five home runs, four triples and 65 total bases. That June he was drafted in the sixth round by the Philadelphia Phillies and after signing, he went on to play three seasons in their system.

Currier earned a master's in physical education from Western Carolina in 1988 where he also served as an assistant coach under Jack Leggett. He was also the head coach at Mitchell Junior College for two seasons prior to returning to Vermont.

FAIRFIELD VS. #1 MANHATTAN

The Stags took the middle game of the series versus Manhattan on May 5, posting a 6-3 win at Alumni Diamond, marking the first win over the Jaspers since 2010. Junior **Jack Giannini** went 5-for-11 versus the Jaspers this season with three runs scored and two RBI.

- Junior **Anthony Hajjar** is a career .324 hitter against the Jaspers with seven runs scored and four runs batted in.
- Manhattan has won 12 of the last 14 meetings with the Stags.

FAIRFIELD VS. #4 RIDER

Fairfield and Rider met during Easter Weekend at Alumni Diamond where the Broncs took two out of three from the Stags. After dropping the first two games, the Stags pulled out a 3-1 victory in the series finale on April 9.

- Senior **Brett Shulick** is 2-0 with 1.69 ERA against Rider. Junior **Mark Bordonaro** is 1-2 against the Broncs with a 3.86 ERA in five appearances. Offensively, senior **Larry Comelia** is a career .286 hitter against Rider.
- The two teams have split the last six meetings while the Broncs hold a 39-23 series advantage.

FAIRFIELD AMONG THE MAAC LEADERS

- The Stags pitching staff leads the MAAC with a 4.01 ERA with opponents hitting just .272. Fairfield is second in the MAAC in strikeouts with 306 and wins with 27, is third in innings pitched (444.0), and leads the league in pickoffs (15).
- Individually, senior **Scott Warwick** leads the league with a 2.80 ERA while freshman **EJ Ashworth** is fourth with a 2.97 ERA, and senior **Brett Shulick** is fifth with a 3.33 ERA. Shulick is tied for second in victories (6) while Ashworth is second in pickoffs (4).
- Offensively, Fairfield is third in runs scored (270), RBI (233), triples (11), is fourth in hits (464), and is fifth in on-base percentage (.354), total bases (.591), and stolen bases (58).
- Sophomore **Ryan Plourde** is third in the league in walks (30), fourth in slugging percentage (.514), and fifth in on-base percentage (.437), home runs (6), and total bases (93). Junior **Anthony Hajjar** is tied for fifth in hits (65) and senior **Larry Comelia** is third in stolen bases (25).
- Defensively, the Stags lead the MAAC with 51 double plays and stand fourth in fielding percentage (.968).

NATIONAL NOTICE

In the NCAA Division I national rankings released on May 20, senior **Larry Comelia** was ranked 33rd in the country in stolen bases with 25. His average of 0.47/g per game ranked him 42nd nationally. As a team, Fairfield is ranked 36th in double plays per game (0.96) and 38th in double plays (51).

LET'S TURN TWO

The Fairfield defense has turned 51 double plays so far this season which is the highest single season total in program history. Fairfield broke the record at Siena on May 12 by turning two double plays against the Saints. Last year, the Stags tied the single season record with 46 double plays. Fairfield has turned three double plays in a game on four different occasions this season, most recently against Canisius on April 29.

MOVING ON UP

With a pair of hits on May 5, junior **Anthony Hajjar** cracked the top-10 on Fairfield's career hits chart. The first baseman currently has 171 career hits which is good for eighth all-time. **Tucker Nathans** holds the career record with 263 hits during his four seasons as a Stag.

KEEPING UP APPEARANCES

- ♦ Junior **Mark Bordonaro** has made 65 career appearances which places him second all-time Fairfield. **Dan Gallagher** holds the record for appearances in a career with 67.
- ♦ The righty has made 22 appearances this season, tying his total from his freshman season. The single season record for appearances is 24 which was set by **Rick Piccirillo** in 2010.
- ♦ Bordonaro has 12 career saves, the second-most in program history. Former Stag **Scott Larkin** is the career saves leader with 19.

IT'S A STEAL

Senior **Larry Comella** has stolen a career-high 25 bases this year and is the first Stag to swipe 20+ bases in a season since 1999. During that campaign, **Tom Lopusznick** stole 33 while **Paul Macchio** had 21 stolen bases. The Fairfield single season record for steals is 37 which was set by **Bill Barnes** in 1978.

SINGLE SEASON RECORDS

- ♦ The Stags defense has broken the single season record for double plays (51).
- ♦ The Stags pitching staff has broken the single season record for innings pitched (444.0).
- ♦ The Stags pitching staff has tied the program record for strikeouts with 306, a mark that was set in 2002.
- ♦ The Stags pitching staff has tied the program record for shutouts in a season with five, a mark that was set in 2007.
- ♦ The Stags have broken the single season record for victories (27).

WINNING WAYS

Senior **Brett Shulick** improved to 6-4 on the season with his victory at Siena on May 12. It is the first time since 2005 in which a pitcher has recorded at least six victories in a season; **Tim Dugan** posted seven wins that season. The Stags single season record for wins is eight which was done four times in program history, most recently by **Dan Krines** in 2000.

HE'S PERFECT...WELL ALMOST

Rookie second baseman **Sal Ciccone** was perfect defensively for Fairfield in his first 233 chances over the course of 45 games as Stag. That streak came to a halt in the fourth inning of the second game of a doubleheader against Manhattan when Ciccone overthrew first base for his first faux pas of the season. Since then, Ciccone has returned to perfection. **Mike Svab** holds the Fairfield record for most consecutive chances without an error, making 307 straight plays without an error in 1987.

THANKS FOR THE HELP

Junior **Jack Giannini** leads the Stags with eight outfield assists this season while freshman centerfielder **Alex Witkus** has six assists. Sophomore **Ryan Plourde** has five assists from the outfield.

HE'S BACK

After missing 25 games with an injury, rookie centerfielder **Alex Witkus** returned to the lineup on April 21, going 2-for-5 with two RBI in Fairfield's 3-1 win at Niagara and reached base in 15 consecutive games with the streak ending on May 18.

HE'S COMING HOME

Freshman reliever **Chris Kalica** is no stranger to upstate New York. The Albany, N.Y. native attended Colonie Central, helping the Raiders to a pair of Suburban Council titles. Kalica was named the *Times Union* Athlete of the Year as a senior. He was also a two-time *Times Union* All-Area First Team selection and a two-time first team All-Area selection by the *Troy Record*. At Fairfield, Kalica notched his first collegiate victory for the Stags in the season finale against Marist on May 18. Kalica threw a scoreless tenth inning setting up heroics for Fairfield in the bottom of the inning. The victory clinched the third seed in the MAAC Championship. Kalica is 1-0 with a 5.61 ERA in 18 appearances.

STRIKE EM OUT

The Stags pitching staff has combined for a program-best 306 strikeouts this season. Fairfield's staff has fanned 10+ batters six times this year, including a season-best 12 batters against Chicago State and against Sacred Heart.

STILL GOING

Shortstop **Larry Comelia** has started 68 consecutive games and 99 of the last 100 games Fairfield has played over the last two seasons. He is the only Stag to start every game this season.

PROVIDING RELIEF

Rookie **Andrew Gallagher** allowed just one run in his 11 appearances between March 3 and April 7, Gallagher throwing 12 scoreless innings of relief. Gallagher resumed the scoreless streak in May and has made four appearances, tossing six scoreless innings of relief. Overall, Gallagher is 1-1 with a save and a 1.99 ERA this season.

STREAKING STAG

Sophomore **Ryan Plourde** has the Stags longest hitting streak this season, hitting in 13 consecutive games between March 2 and March 18.

SAVING IT

Junior **Kyle Capaldo** saved both games of the Stags' doubleheader sweep at Siena on May 11. He tossed a combined 3.1 innings for scoreless relief allowing just one hit while striking out two batters.

A-OK APRIL

The Stags pitching staff combined for a 3.34 ERA during the month of April. Rookie **EJ Ashworth** was 2-1 last month and had a miniscule 0.93 ERA. Senior **Brett Shulick** went 3-1 with a 1.17 ERA while senior **Scott Warwick** had a 1.98 ERA with 24 strikeouts in 27.1 innings.

UNLEASH THE OFFENSE

The Stags unleashed their offense on NJIT downing the Highlanders on May 14, posting 19 runs on 20 hits for its highest offensive output of the season. All but one Stag that entered the game recorded a hit. The last time Fairfield had 20 or more hits in a game was at UMBC in 2011.

IT'S A LONG ONE

The Stags played their second extra inning game of the season at Niagara on April 22. The game scheduled for seven innings lasted 10 innings with the Stags prevailing, 4-2.

MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK – 5/21

Junior **Anthony Hajjar** was named the MAAC Player of the Week on May 21 after he hit .500 (8-for-16), slugged .750, drove in eight runs, including two game-winners, and posted an on-base percentage of .529 to power the Stags to a 3-1 week. The first baseman was flawless defensively in 38 chances. Hajjar began the week by going 4-for-5 with two doubles, a triple, a walk, five RBI and two runs scored in a 19-4 non-league rout of NJIT. In the Stags' 1-0 victory over Marist on Thursday, Hajjar drove in the game's only run which clinched Fairfield's first MAAC Championship berth in more than a decade. In the first game of Friday's doubleheader, Hajjar went 3-for-3 with an RBI and a run scored. In the regular season finale, Hajjar drove in the game-winning run, a walk-off single with one out in the bottom of the tenth inning.

MAAC PITCHER OF THE WEEK – 5/21

Freshman **EJ Ashworth** was named the MAAC Pitcher of the Week on May 21 after helping the Stags clinch their first MAAC Championships berth in more than a decade. Ashworth turned in a dominant performance against Marist on Thursday, tossing 6.2 scoreless innings, striking out seven batters and scattering four hits to combine for his first career shutout. After allowing a pair of hits in the second inning, the right hander retired seven of the next eight batters he faced. He also fanned three of the final six batters he faced in his outing.

MAAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK – 5/14

Junior **Jack Giannini** was named the MAAC Player of the Week on May 14 after powering the Stags to a crucial three-game sweep of Siena College. Giannini hit .417 (5-for-12) and slugged .667 with seven RBI and two runs scored. He was also strong defensively, recording eight putouts and a crucial outfield assist. In the opening game against the Saints, Giannini drove in a run, but more importantly, gunned down the potential tying run at the plate with a perfect throw from left field; the Stags went on to win 7-4. In game two of the doubleheader, Giannini scored the Stags' first run of the contest and later drove in the game-winning runs with a two-RBI single with two outs in the top of the seventh for the 5-3 victory. In the final game of the series, Giannini blasted his first collegiate home run, a three-run shot in the third inning.

MAAC PITCHER OF THE WEEK – 4/30

Senior **Scott Warwick** was named the MAAC Co-Pitcher of the Week on April 30 after a stellar outing against Canisius College on Saturday. Warwick tossed a four-hit complete game shutout and struck out a season-high nine batters to lead the Stags to a 4-0 victory over Canisius on April 28. Warwick allowed just one walk during his seven inning outing. The right hander retired 10 of the first 11 batters he faced, striking out five of those hitters. He also retired the final five batters of the game, striking out the last two Griffs of the day. Warwick shared the accolade with Manhattan College's Taylor Sewitt.

MAAC PITCHER OF THE WEEK – 4/23

Senior **Brett Shulick** was named MAAC Pitcher of the Week on April 23 after a masterful performance in the Stags' 13-1 victory at Niagara University on April 22. The right hander scattered three hits and struck out a season-high seven batters in 8.0 shutout innings. Shulick, who needed just 76 pitches for his fourth victory of the year, did not walk a batter or allow an extra base hit during his outing. Shulick flirted with a perfect game through 4.2 innings, retiring the first 14 batters of the game. After allowing back-to-back singles in the fifth, Shulick retired eight-straight batters until giving up a one-out hit in the eighth inning.

CURRIER POSTS 500TH WIN

With the doubleheader sweep of Yale University on April 11, Head Coach **Bill Currier** recorded his 500th career victory as a Division I head coach. Currier has an overall coaching record of 503-490 in 23 seasons as a head coach. Currier was 486-470 in 22 seasons as the head coach at Vermont.

LOTS OF HITS

The Stags pounded out a season-high 18 hits in their 9-0 win over Fordham on April 3. Fairfield also posted 25 total bases and five doubles, both season highs.

WHAT A COMBO

Three Stags pitchers combined for a 9-0 shutout victory over Fordham University on April 3. Freshman **Jeremy Soule** got his second win of the season after scattering four hits and two walks with two strikeouts over 5.1 innings. Freshman **Chris Kalica** threw 2.2 hitless innings of relief while senior **Gavin McCullough** closed it out in the ninth.

WHAT A WIN

Rookie **EJ Ashworth** notched his first collegiate victory, throwing 5.0 scoreless innings of relief giving up just one hit and two walks while mowing down seven batters against Quinnipiac on March 27. Ashworth faced the minimum in his first two innings of work and the Bobcats got their lone hit off of Ashworth with one out in the eighth inning.
